Marvelous advances continue to be made in computer technology. “IBM showed off a prototype chip today that is being hailed as a technological breakthrough for the tiny transistors — electrical switches that help power a computer — that have been made so thin they’re 1/10,000th the width of a human hair”. The breakthrough — the result of research at IBM and the State University of New York Polytechnic Institute in Albany — could allow as many as 20 billion transistors to be placed on a chip the size of a fingernail and is half the size of the current 14 nanometer standard, company officials said. A nanometer is one-billionth of a meter. (“IBM: What Make This Tiny Chip a Breakthrough”, Alyssa Newcomb, abcnews.go.com). There is no doubt that intelligence produced the computer chip as well as this amazing reduction in its size. We know these even smaller chips did not evolve by themselves. Now, consider the neurons in your brain. “Your brain is made of approximately 100 billion nerve cells, called neurons. Neurons have the amazing ability to gather and transmit electrochemical signals — think of them like the gates and wires in a computer” (How Your Brain Works”, Craig Freudenrich, Ph.D, and Robynne Boyd, science.howstuffworks.com).
