OUR RELATIONSHIPS TO CHRIST Marc Gibson

Our relationship to Jesus Christ takes many forms at the same time. Consider a few:

Disciple

"If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free" (John 8:31-32). A disciple is a learner, one who follows and listens in order to learn. The Christian is a disciple of Jesus Christ, patterning himself after the teacher in every aspect.

Servant

Family

"For whoever does the will of My Father in heaven is My brother and sister and mother" (Matthew 12:50). The disciples and servants of Christ are His family. Spiritual ties are more significant than earthly ones. Jesus is not ashamed to call His followers "brethren" (Hebrews 2:11-12).

Friend

"You are My friends if you do whatever I command you" (John 15:14). A true friend loves at all times (Proverbs 17:17). I'll be a friend to Jesus when I fulfill His will for me. No better friend is there than He. A faithful friend to Him I must be.
