John 16:13

However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.

Jude 3

Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints.

THE FAITH = an organized and formal body of truth which exists today. This is the New Testament and is the basis of our personal faith (see Romans 1:16-17; 10:17).

ONCE FOR ALL = this body of truth is complete and unalterable, being delivered to all men at a single time period of history – the first century AD. (Ephesians 3:3-5)

DELIVERED = this body of truth was delivered by divine authority from heaven, not from any human council or denominational creed (see 1 Corinthians 2:6-13)

TO THE SAINTS = this body of truth was delivered to the people of God (2 Peter 1:3; 1 Corinthians 15:1-3). This word of salvation is to be taken into all the world that people lost in sin may hear, believe, and obey for the remission of their sins.

All truth has been revealed.

We are to preach no other gospel.

"Latter-day revelations" are false and deceptive!
