

AT THE FEET OF JESUS

(Part 2)

Introduction

- 1) The Bible speaks of those who were “*at the feet of Jesus*” – Jesus took notice of them!
 - a) In our previous study we found at the feet of Jesus those who sorrow for their sins (Lk. 7:37-38), those who are thankful to God (Lk. 17:16), and those who have a desire to learn the truth (Lk. 10:39).
- 2) We are to submit our lives to God in all humility (Jas. 4:6, 10)
 - a) Jesus has all authority in heaven and on earth (Matt. 28:18; Eph. 1:20-23)
 - b) All should humble themselves at the throne/feet of Jesus (Phil. 2:9-11)
 - c) Those who refuse to hear and obey Jesus will be lost (Matt. 7:26-27; 2 Thess. 1:7-9)
- 3) The Scriptures tell us about those at the feet of Jesus who are...

I) **NEEDING HEALING**

- A) Many who *needed healing and help* were brought to the feet of Jesus (Matt. 15:29-31)
 - 1) Jarius fell at the feet of Jesus begging Him to heal his sick daughter (Mk. 5:22-24)
 - 2) The woman with the problem flow of blood fell down before Jesus (Mk. 5:25-34)
 - 3) A Syro-Phoenician woman fell at the feet of Jesus asking Him to cast a demon out of her daughter (Mk. 7:24-30)
- B) Jesus came to bear the infirmities of man, both physical and spiritual (Matt. 8:16-17)
 - 1) Only by God’s gracious provisions are we helped and healed (Jas. 1:17)
 - 2) We are exhorted to “come boldly to the throne of grace to obtain mercy and to find grace to help in time of need” (Heb. 4:16)
 - 3) Suffering and sickness humble us before the God of healing to find help (Jas. 5:13-14)
 - a) The healing may not remove the affliction, but strengthen the person (2 Cor. 12:9-10)
- C) Are you found at the feet of Jesus when you need healing and help?

II) **UNDERGOING CHANGE**

- A) A demon-possessed man was at the feet of Jesus having *undergone a change* (Lk. 8:26-36)
 - 1) The people noticed a visible change in the man (v. 35)
 - a) *Sitting* – sober, self-controlled, calm
 - b) *At the feet of Jesus* – spiritual, attentive, content
 - c) *Clothed* – modest, self-aware, good judgment
 - d) *In his right mind* – proper reasoning and discernment, free of evil and error (Col. 3:1-2)
- B) Will you undergo a change that puts you in your right mind at the feet of Jesus?

III) **JOYFULLY WORSHIPING**

- A) The women held the feet of Jesus *and worshiped Him* (Matt. 28:9)
 - 1) We are to worship God – Jesus is divine (Matt. 4:10; 1:23; Jn. 1:1, 14)
- B) Jesus is worthy of worship (Matt. 2:11; 14:33; Heb. 1:6; Rev. 5:11-14)
 - 1) We do not worship men or angels (Acts 10:25-26; Rev. 22:8-9)
- C) Are you found at the feet of Jesus with a desire to worship your Savior?

Conclusion

If you seek to sit at the feet of Jesus today, you must become a member of His body, the church. The Lord calls spiritual Zion “the place of My feet” (Isa. 60:13). Will you obey Jesus today?
