- 2) Jesus affirms that He is the one and only *way*, the absolute *truth*, and the only source of *life* a) Each of these claims are worthy of our study and meditation they are critical to our
 - successfully "coming to the Father" (fellowship, salvation, eternal life)
- 3) This lesson will study Jesus as THE TRUTH

I) Various Answers Given to the Question "What is Truth?" (John 18:38)

- A) *Relativism* truth only exists relative to one's perspective, culture, or history
- B) *Pluralism* all truths are accepted as equally valid
- C) *Agnosticism* truth is unknown and probably unknowable
- D) *Superstition* truth is often contrary to the facts
- E) *Revelation* truth has been divinely revealed and can be known by man

II) "Truth"

- A) Gk. aletheia truth, verity, reality, fact, certainty; free from falsehood, deceit, error
- B) The truth of a matter concerns what is real and factual about it (1 Thess. 2:13; Matt. 14:33) 1) True testimony reveals what is truth, not opinion or deception (3 Jn. 12; Prov. 12:17)
- C) Many in our world doubt or deny the existence of absolute truth (Jn. 18:38)
 - 1) "There are no eternal facts, as there are no absolute truths" *Friedrich Nietzsche*
 - 2) A denial of an objective standard that applies to every area of our lives (1 Thess. 4:1-2)

- A) God is a God of truth (Deut. 32:4; Jn. 17:17)
- B) Jesus is God (Jn. 1:1, 14; 20:28; Col. 1:15; 2:9)
- C) Jesus made known God the Father (Jn. 1:18; 1 Jn. 5:20)
- D) Divine objective, absolute, and complete truth came by Jesus (Jn. 1:14, 17; 18:37; Heb. 1:1-2)
 - 1) If we abide in His word and are His disciples, we shall know the truth (Jn. 8:31-32)
 - 2) Need to hear and be taught by Jesus, because "the truth is in Jesus" (Eph. 4:21)
 - 3) Hear the "word of truth, the gospel of your salvation" which has come into all the world (Eph. 1:13; Col. 1:5-6)

- A) Are spiritually born of God (Jas. 1:18)
- B) Are set free from sin (Jn. 8:32-36; Rom. 6:17-18)
- C) Put on the new man (Eph. 4:21-24)
