BE THANKFUL

Introduction

- 1) Colossians 3:12-15 "...and be thankful" (v. 15); a simple, yet crucial exhortation
- 2) Each generation should be taught the important values of saying "please" and "thank you" a) Reflection of politeness, respect, and thankfulness
- 3) God's people should be thankful people (1 Chron. 16:8; Psa. 100:4; Phil. 4:6; Col. 4:2)
 - a) The failure to give God glory and thanks is among the first steps into apostasy (Rom. 1:21)
- 4) In a time filled with filthy and foolish talk, we need to emphasize the giving of thanks (Eph. 5:4)
- 5) The Bible shows that the attitude of thanksgiving should fill the heart of every Christian

I) Giving Thanks in Everything (1 Thessalonians 5:18)

- A) Reasons for God's faithful people to give thanks
 - 1) God is good (Psa. 107:1, 8-9, 15, 21, 31, 43)
 - 2) God is in control (Job 1:21; Jonah 2:9)
 - 3) God provides (1 Tim. 4:3-5; 1 Cor. 11:24-25)
 - 4) God protects (Phil. 4:6-7)
 - 5) God gives victory (1 Cor. 15:57)
- B) The true test of giving thanks is doing so when we do *not* get what we want (2 Cor. 12:7-10)

II) Lessons from a Thankful Leper (Luke 17:11-19)

- A) Understand your need (vv. 12-13)
- B) Trust in those who can help (v. 14)

- C) Forgiveness letting go of bitterness and resentment allows a return to thankfulness
- D) **Love** loving God and our fellow man encourages a more thankful nature
- E) **Peace** the peace of God ruling in the heart inspires gratitude and contentment
- F) Wisdom using God's truth to discern what we truly should be thankful for
- G) Worship bringing our offerings to God from humble hearts full of gratitude
- H) Service faithful obedience to God who gives all men life, breath, and all things
